The Board on consideration of which do order and direct that the said Jacob Shumir be released from the said fines.

The Petitioner states that the said Lathams Roads was attacked with the yellow Fever and was prevented from attending Court. He therefore prays to be released from said Recognizance. The Board on consideration of which circumstance and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do order and direct that the said Thomas White be released from the said Recognizance.
