The Council met. Present The Honble Thomas Buchanan, James Thomas and John Davidson.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M<sup>rs</sup> Ann LeVacke, the sum of fifteen pounds for one quarter half pay; due the first instant.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Minian Pinkney, the sum of twenty five pounds current Money for one quarter salary as Clerk of the Council; due the first instant.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to John H. Stone, the sum of forty two pounds three Shillings and nine pence for one quarter half pay; due this day.
