Wednesday June the 2^d 1801

The Council met. Present as on yesterday.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Wilmot, the sum of twenty
pounds four shillings and seven pence, for riding Exp^s, as per account passed by the Auditor.

Thursday June the 4th 1801

The Council met. Present The Honble Thomas Buchanan, Arthur Shaaff, James Thomas, John
Davidson and Samuel Bidout.

John Ford was appointed a Justice of the Peace of Anne Arundel County, and Commission
issued to the said County including him.

Friday June the 5th 1801

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Council.

The Petition of Henry Roberts of Baltimore County, praying stating that he had made
application to Harford and Baltimore County Courts, and to the General Court, to be
admitted as an attorney of the same, and that he had been refused in his said application
and praying that the Executive would grant him relief, was unanimously rejected.

By the Petition of Jacob Bligher of Allegany County it appears that he was pun-
ished in two cases for uttailing liquors against law, and was fined six hundred pounds
of Tobacco in each. - The Petitioner states that he called on Hanson Biscoe one of
the associate Justices of the said County in order to apply for a licence but was
disappointed in getting one Mr. Biscoe being absent from home. - The Petitioner
states that he communicated the Business to Mr. Biscoe's Clerk, and deposited the
necessary sum to pay for a licence until the next Term, with directions to inform Mr.
Biscoe of the application and Money left. - He therefore prays to be released
from the said fines. - The Board on considering which and from the recommendation
of the Court of the said County do order and direct that he be released from the
said fines.
