Thursday July the 2. 1801

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Arthur Shaaff, John Davidjon and Samuel Bidout.

By the Petition of Elizabeth Knight of Baltimore County it appears that she was presented and found guilty of selling liquors without licence and was by the said Court at March Term last fined six hundred pounds of Tobacco. The Petitioner states that she is upwards of seventy years of age and extremely poor. She therefore prays to be released from the said fine. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do order and direct that the said Elizabeth Knight be released from the said fine.
