

Thursday July the 24. 1801

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Arthur Shaaff, James Thomas, and John Davidfon.

By the Petition of Augustus Whittly of Dorchester County it appears that he was presented in six several presentments for selling liquors without licence and was fined by the Court of the said County the sum of six pounds on each. The Petitioner states that he violated the law through ignorance he having been led into the error by a licence obtained by him from the United States. The petitioner further states that his circumstances are very slender. He therefore prays to be released from the said fines. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the above fines.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Thomas Buchanan, Arthur Shaaff, James Thomas and John Davidfon.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Lynn, the sum of fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay; due this day.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William J. Green Esquire, the sum of fourteen pounds one shilling and three pence for one quarters salary as Clerk of the Senate: due as above.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Thomas Esquire, the sum of fifty pounds, for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council; due as above.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Harwood Esquire, the sum of twenty eight pounds two shillings and six pence, for one quarters salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates; due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Minian Pinkney the sum of twenty five pounds, for one quarters salary as Clerk of the Council: due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Arthur Shaaff Esquire, the sum of fifty pounds, for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council; due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Buchanan Esquire, the sum of fifty pounds, for one quarters salary as a Member of the Council: due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Gabriel Duval Esquire, the sum of one hundred and eighty seven pounds ten shillings, for one quarters salary as a Judge of the General Court: due as above.
