

Friday October the 2. 1801

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Thomas Buchanan, Arthur Shaaff, John Davidfon and James Thomas.

Robert Goldsborough was appointed an associate Justice for Talbot County in the Room of William Hayward resigned, and Commission issued to John Roberts and Robert Goldsborough as associate Justices of the said County.

Richard Duckitt was appointed a Justice of the Peace and Levy Court for Prince Georges County and New Commissions issued to the said County including him.

James A. Maguire and John Hodges were appointed Justices of the Peace for Prince Georges County and a New Commission issued to the said County including them.

Monday October the 5. 1801

Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Council

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonathan Pinkney, Esquire, the Sum of Nineteen pounds Eleven Shillings and Three pence for articles furnished for the use of the Council, as per Account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to M^r. John Shaw, the Sum of three hundred Dollars, to be by him accounted for.

Tuesday October the 6. 1801

The Council met. Present The Honble James Thomas, John Davidfon and Samuel Bidout.

William Thomas was appointed one of the Judges of the Orphans Court for Talbot County in the room of David Stee resigned, and Commission issued to William Dawson, Hugh Sherwood and William Thomas, as Judges of the Orphans Court for said County.

Saturday October the 10. 1801

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Council.

The Board proceeded to fill up the Vacancies in the Court of Appeals occasioned by the deaths of James Murray and Solomon Wright. Where William Fooker and Richard Potts were appointed. Whereupon Commission issued to the honble Benjamin Rumsey, Benjamin Machall, Thomas Jones, William Fooker and Richard Potts as Judges of the High Court of Appeals.

Monday October the 12. 1801

The Council met. Present all the Council.

Robert Darden was appointed a Judge of the Orphans Court for Queen Anne's County vice Arthur Emory deceased and Commission issued to Philip Fiddemon, Christopher W. Partridge and Robert Darden.
