

It appearing to the Executive by a Transcript of the Record, from the Court of Prince Georges County, in the case of the State against Gabriel P. Van Horn, that the said Van Horn was presented, at September Term 1800, by the Grand Inquest for said County, for receiving fees as a Justice of the Peace contrary to law; and it also appearing by said Record to the Executive that, at September Term in this present year, the said Van Horn was convicted by the Justices of Prince Georges County Court aforesaid, of said Offence, and that he was fined by said Court one hundred Dollars for said Offence, therefore Resolved, that the said Gabriel P. Van Horn shall be, and he is hereby dismissed from the Office of a Justice of the Peace for Prince Georges County.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Joseph Simmons one pound two Shillings and six pence as per account passed.

Wednesday October 14. 1801

The Council met. Present The Honble James Thomas, John Davidson and Samuel Bidout.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Abraham Gambell, six pounds fifteen Shillings, for one quarters pension, due the first instant.

Thursday October the 15. 1801

The Council met. Present The Honble James Thomas, John Davidson and Samuel Bidout.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Baker Johnson, Esquire, the sum of thirty pounds, as per account passed by the Auditor.

Tuesday October the 20. 1801

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Council

David Herr was appointed an associate Justice for Talbot County vice John Roberts resigned, and Commission issued accordingly to Robert Galdenborough and David Herr as associate Justices of the said County.

Thursday October the 22. 1801
