Jacob Harry was appointed a Justice of the Orphans Court for Washington County vice Benjamin Galloway and Commission given to Ignatius Taylor, Eli Williams and Jacob Harry as Justices of the Orphans Court for the said County.

Jacob Harry was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Washington County, and Commission given to the said County including him and leaving out Alexander Flagitt.

Ordered, that a Commission given to the Justices of the Levy Court for Washington County who were appointed on the first week day of December last dated as of today.
