Ordered that the Resolution of the last Session of the Assembly respecting the Debtors of the State be published in the Maryland Gazette at Annapolis, the Federal Gazette, the American and the Telegrapher at Baltimore, the Museum at George Town, the National Intelligencer, one of the Papers at Easton and the Washington Spy three times in each week for the space of three weeks successively for information, and all delinquent Debtors are notified that unless they make satisfactory payments to the Treasurer of the Western or Eastern Shore (as the case may be) on or before the tenth day of March next, suits will be commenced against them indiscriminately.
