The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Messrs. B. Ducket, Beverly Ghidlin and Edward Hall.

William Thomas was appointed an associate Justice for Saint Marys County vice Henry Neale resigned, and Commission issued to Barton Talb and William Thomas as associate Justices of said County.

Henry Gardiner was appointed a Judge of the Orphans Court for Saint Marys County vice William Thomas appointed an associate Justice, and Commission issued to William Sommersell, Edmund Plowden and Henry Gardiner as Justices of the Orphans Court for said County.

William Hill, John Gerard Ford and Thomas Barber were appointed Justices of the Levy Court for Saint Marys County vice James Fenwick, George Plater and Henry Gardiner and a New Commission issued to the said County including them.

Ignatius Abell and Michael Fenwick were appointed Justices of the Peace for Saint Marys County, and a New Commission issued to the said County including them.

Doctor Samuel Hanson was appointed a Justice of the Levy Court for Charles County vice John Mitchell resigned and a New Commission issued to the said County including him.

Ordered, that Colonel John Stricker transmit to this place one hundred stand of the Public arms.

Ordered, that the Armour at Frederick Town forward to this place Nine half Barrels of Powder.
