Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Shaw, one hundred and fifty four pounds seven shillings and three pence half penny, as per account paid by the Auditor.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mr. John Shaw the sum of one hundred pounds to purchase wood for the use of the General Assembly.

Monday November the 1<sup>st</sup> 1802

The Council met. Present The Honble Francis Digges, Allen B. Duckett, Purvady Gheslin and Edward Hall.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honble Francis Digges one hundred pounds for six Months Salary as a Member of the Council due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honble Gabriel Swann one hundred and eighty four pounds ten shillings for one quarters Salary as Judge of the General Court due this day.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Colonel John H. Stone, the sum of forty two pounds three shillings and nine pence current Money, for one quarters half pay, due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to the Honble John Stone the sum of one hundred and eighty seven pounds ten shillings for one quarters salary as a Judge of the General Court, due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to the honble Thomas Jones the sum of ninety three pounds fifteen shillings for one quarters Salary as a Judge of the Court of Appeals due the first instant
