Friday February the 11. 1803

The Council met. Present as on yesterday.

William Whittington was re-appointed Inspector of Tobacco at Lower Marlboro Warehouse in Calvert County and James Thimier was appointed Inspector of Tobacco at Hunting Creek.

Joseph Haore was appointed Inspector of Tobacco at St. Leonards Creek Warehouse in Calvert County and Commission issued to him accordingly.

John Mackall Gantt was appointed Chief Justice of the first Judicial District vice The Honble Richard Sprigg resigned, and Commission issued.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honble Francis Digges, the sum of fifty pounds for one quarters salary as a member of the Council: due the first instant.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honble Allen B. Duckett, the sum of fifty pounds for one quarters salary as a member of the Council: due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to John Wilnot out of the Contingent Fund ten dollars for riding expens: as per account passed.
