

On application of Daniel Farrell and Zachariah Mackubin of the County of Warrington for a preference in the purchase of several Tracts or Parcels of Land lying in the County aforesaid, being part of Islington, Northhead and Buckrange which are said to be liable to confiscation. The Board agreed to sell the States Right to said Parcel of Land to said Farrell and Mackubin for the sum of three Dollars per acre: The said Farrell and Mackubin to give Bond with approved Security when the number of acres shall be ascertained by an actual Survey to be made by the Surveyor of Batturee County, the expense of said Survey to be defrayed by said Farrell and Mackubin and the said sum of three Dollars per acre to be independent of the one third part of the value of the said Parcels of Land to which the said Farrell and Mackubin are entitled in consequence of having given information as aforesaid. It is also ordered, that the Survey be made and Bond given as before directed, on or before the first day of May next. The Credit to be as long as the Governor and Council are authorized to give under the Act of the last Session, authorizing them to compound in cases of this kind.
