The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Allen. B. Duckett, Edward Hall and Riverdy Gheisler.

On the application of Benjamin Stoddert Ordred, that no suit be brought on the Bond given by Uriah Forrest, Gustavus Scott, and Francis Deakins to the State on the twenty seventh day of August fourteen hundred and Ninety nine for six hundred and thirtyn pounds seven shillings and six pence until the further order of the Executive, provided that the Interest due on the said Bond, up to the first day of May next, be paid to the Treasurer of the Western Shore on or before that day.

Ordred, that no suit be commenced on the Bond given by William Miley and others to the State of Maryland, for Indian Lands sold by Henry H. Harwood late agent, until the next session of asembly provided that the Interest due on the said Bond up to this date be paid to the Treasurer of the Western Shore on or before the first day of April next.

Ordred, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Wilnot out of the contingent Fund fourteen pounds five shillings for riding Expes, as per account passed by the auditor.

On the application of Samuel Maynard of Anne Arundel County for a preference in the purchase of a part of a tract of land called Smiths Delight lying in the County aforesaid which is said to be liable to confiscation. The Board agreed to sell the States right to said Parcel of Land to said Maynard for the sum of three dollars per acre. The quantity of acres to be ascertained by an
