

George W. Jackson was appointed a Justice of the Levy Court for Somerset County vice John Hayward deceased and a New Commission issued to the said County including him.

John Dorgan was appointed Inspector of Tobacco at St. Michaels Warehouse in D. & C. County and Commission issued to him for the said Warehouse in Talbot County.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Maguire appointed Trustee of the Children of the late Pignal Hillery deceased one hundred and sixty two pounds fifteen Shillings for half pay due Pignal Hillery on the first day of April last the time when he arrived to the age of twenty one Years.

The Council direct that the Attorney General have the Executions which issued out of the General Court against Charles Mashier and returned to May Term 1803 entered on the Dockett not called by consent.

Ordered, that Mr. John Shaw cause the State Pump to be repaired agreeably to an Estimate returned by him: The expense not to exceed one hundred and ten Dollars.

The Council met Present as on Saturday.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Nicholas White, for his Services as armour at Frederick Town from the first day of November to the first of May instant the sum of Ninety six pounds current Money, and that the said Nicholas White be continued as armour till the first day of November next on the same terms and conditions on which he has heretofore held the said appointment.

Ordered, that the Attorney General be required to ascertain the State of the Claim of this State against David M'Fua and William Dawson, and to take such legal Steps as will be necessary and proper in a suit to recover the Land heretofore sold to the said M'Fua and remaining unpaid for: for the use and benefit of the State.

Nicholas Swell and William Mills were appointed Justices of the Peace for Saint Marys County and a New Commission issued to the said County including them.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Hall Harwood Cozier, the sum of twenty five Dollars and twenty four Cents for attending the Eastern Shore General Court by the direction of the Treasurer as per account passed by the Auditor.
