Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Ann Swackie, the sum of 75 pounds for one quarter's half pay, due the first instant.

On the further application of Samuel Maynard of Anne Arundel County for a preference in the purchase of a part of a tract of land called Smith's Delight lying in the said County containing fifty acres more or less which is said to be liable to confiscation. The Board agreed to sell the States Right to said Parcel of land for the sum of three dollars per acre: and the said part of a tract is taken to contain fifty acres more or less.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honorable Francis Bigger, fifty pounds, for one quarter's salary as a Member of the Council: due the first instant.
