Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore be authorized and required to suspend until the first day of January next all procs against William Singleton and George Johnston, for or on account of a purchase made by them of the State of Maryland in the year 1785 of lands sold as part of the Welch Tract in Cecil County.

It being represented to the Council that a Survey made by William Barrow former Surveyor of Dorchester County of a lot of Land No 13 sold to Charles Seecompte by the State of Maryland, and which has been revised by the Examiner General a mistake had been committed by estimating the number of Acres at 317 instead of 291 1/2 by which means a Bond had been taken for the sum of 958 18 6. It is therefore ordered that on the paying up the sum of twenty three pounds four shillings and nine pence and Interest the Treasurer of the Western Shore may suspend all Procs against the said Charles Seecompte until the first day of January next.
