By the Petition of James M. Mills of Saint Marys County it appears that he was presented at August Term last and was fined the quantity of five hundred pounds of Tobacco for not doing his duty as Overseer of the Roads. The Petitioner states that long previous to the appointing Overseers of the Roads by the Jury Court in 1802, he being very unwell and not able to perform the duties of Overseer or even to attend the Court, did request Mr. Henry Gardiner then one of the Jury Court to have some other person appointed, but from some cause, owing either to the ignorance of your Petitioner, in not knowing it was necessary to return his Warrant or from Mr. Gardiner's not applying as requested, the Court appointed him as Overseer of the Road, and notwithstanding he was appointed he most solemnly declares, he never received the Warrant until November after he was presented, at which time he was and continued for some time to be, too ill to do the ordinary business in his family. The Petitioner states that he is poor, has eight small children and a helpless Wife now compelled to use crutches. The Board on consideration and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fine.
