Thomas Thistle was appointed a Justice of the Orphans Court for Allegany County vice William Linnar, and Commission issued to Andrew Bruce, Thomas Linnar and Thomas Thistle as Justices of the Orphans Court for said County.

By the Petition of John Holladay of Anne Arundel County accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he was punished at April Term 1802 for selling liquors without license and was fined on each the sum of six pounds amounting in the whole to the sum of twenty four pounds. The Petitioner states that his young son took a small quantity of Black Brandy to a militia meeting in the summer eight or ten hundred and that in the course of the day the Petitioner assisted in measuring and selling the same. The Petitioner states that he acted altogether from ignorance not knowing that it was against Law. He further states that he has a numerous family of children and a wife depending on him for support. The Board on consideration and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the same.
