

Wednesday October the 13. 1803

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Francis Biggs, Edward Hall and Purdy Ghieslin

The Board received the Return of the Auction of Sheriffs for Worcester County declaring Robert Nairn and Joshua Sims as duly elected: Whereupon Commission issued to Robert Nairn as Sheriff of the said County.

William Thomas was appointed an associate Justice for Saint Marys County and Commission issued to Barton Tabbs and William Thomas as associate Justices for the said County.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Thomas Guiver, out of the Contingent Fund, Nine pounds sixteen Shillings and ten pence half penny, for printing done for the State as per account passed.

By the Petition of Levi Outten of Worcester County it appears that he entered into a Recognizance in the sum of one hundred pounds for the appearance of certain Thomas Outten to answer a presentment for forgery. The Petitioner states that he is possessed of a small property, has a wife who is blind, seven children most of them small. The Petitioner further states that the said Thomas son of the Petitioner has left the State never to return. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the whole of the said forfeiture of one hundred pounds.
