

The Board being in possession of Returns from the several Counties of this State of the Election lately held for the choice of Representatives in the Congress of the United States, provided equally to the directions of the acts of Assembly in such case made and provided, to innumerate and ascertain the Votes given for each person voted for as aforesaid when it appeared that John Campbell, Leonard Covington, Patrick Magruder, Roger Nelson, Nicholas Quaton Moore, William McFury, John Archer, Joseph Hopper Nicholson, and Charles Goldborough Coqueris had the greatest number of Votes, wherefore it is hereby certified and declared that the said John Campbell, Leonard Covington, Patrick Magruder, Roger Nelson, Nicholas Quaton Moore, William McFury, John Archer, Joseph Hopper Nicholson, and Charles Goldborough Coqueris are duly elected Representatives of this State in the Congress of the United States. Given in Council at the City of Annapolis, under the Seal of the State of Maryland this twenty eighth day of November in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and four.

The following Proclamation was accordingly issued
A Proclamation

By His Excellency Robert Bowie Governor of Maryland
Whereas the General Assembly of Maryland did by an act passed at November Session Seventeen hundred and ninety entitled "an act directing the time, place and manner of holding Elections for Representatives of this State in the Congress of the United States, and for the regulation of the said Elections, and also to repeal the act of Assembly therein mentioned" direct that the Governor and Council after having received the Returns, Papers and Instruments containing the number of Votes for Representatives of this State in the Congress of the United States, should innumerate and ascertain the number of Votes for every candidate and person chosen as a Representative, and by Proclamation signed by the Governor and dispersed through the State, should declare the Names of the Persons duly elected, as Representatives: We in pursuance of the directions of the said act, do by this our Proclamation declare that by the Returns made to us it appears that John Campbell Coqueris was elected for the first district: Leonard Covington Coqueris, was elected for the second district: Patrick Magruder Coqueris was elected for the third district: Roger Nelson Coqueris was elected for the fourth
