Alis Chandler was appointed Surveyor of Calvert County vice William Humphreys and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Division shall pay to Mr John Shaw out of the Contingent Fund twelve pounds fifteen shillings for taking care of the Government House and for the paper account paper.
