The Council met. Present The Honorable Richard Hall Harwood, Allen Bowie Buckett and Purdy Chesler and Francis Biggs.

Richard Butler Esquire, was appointed Register of Wills for Frederick County vice George Murdock dead, and Commission issued to him to hold the said Office until the meeting of the next General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas W. Hall, Esquire, fourteen pounds one shilling and three pence for one quarter's Salary as Clerk of the Senate, due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Wilmot thirteen pounds and three shillings out of the Contingent Fund for riding Expence to the Honble John M. Gantt, William Clagitt, William Holmes and Richard Turner Esquires, with a Special Commission.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay out of the Contingent Fund to Edward Holland three dollars as per account passed.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to the Honble Richard Sprigg, one thousand dollars, for six Months Salary as Judge of the General Court, due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Act to provide for the trial of facts in the several Counties of this State, and to alter, change and abolish all such parts of the Constitution and Form of Government as relate to the General Court and Court of Appeals be published twice in each Week for the space of three Months in the Maryland Gazette at Annapolis: the American Telegrapher and Federal Gazette at Baltimore: the National Intelligencer: the Republican Advocate and Patriot Paper at Frederick Town: Queen's Paper at Hagerstown and in Smith's and Cowen's Papers at Easton.
