Monday May the 20. 1805

Ordered by The Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain James Somerville forty five pounds for six Months half pay due the first Instant.

Ordered by The Governor, that the said Treasurer pay to Captain Richard Anderson, forty five pounds, for six Months half pay, due as above.

Wednesday May the 22. 1805

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and The Honble Richard Hall Harwood, Allen. B. Duckett, Nevady Ghiselin and Francis Biggs.

Ordered that Olofus Nelson Esquire be empowered to superintend the collection of a debt due the State from a certain Benjamin Spyer and John Trammell of Frederick County and take all necessary and legal steps for prosecuting said claim to final recovery and that he be allowed for his services and trouble the sum of three hundred Dollars, if he shall recover the whole sum claimed and cause it to be paid into the Treasury.

It being represented that Charles Maddox appointed one of the Coroners for Prince Georges County on... day of May 1801 forfeited his Commission on account of his not giving Bond within the time prescribed by law. Ordered that a new Commission issue to him. Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Thomas Gwinn one pound nine shillings and three pence for printing done by order of the Governor and Council, as per account passed by the Auditor.

William M. Math was appointed Coroner for Harford County and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honble Richard Potts Ninety three pounds fifteen shillings for one quarters Salary as Judge of the Court of Appeals due the first Instant.
