Ordered that Mr. John Shaw be requested to have one hundred pounds of the Public Powder made into Musket Cartridges and fifty pounds into Cannon Cartridges as soon as convenient and that he cause as much of the lead belonging to the State, as will be necessary for said Musket Cartridges to be run into Balls of the proper size.

Nathaniel Hancock was appointed a coroner for Anne Arundel County and a Commission issued to him accordingly

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Littleton Burrows five hundred Dollars for six Months Salary as a Judge of the Court of Appeals due the first day of May last.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Captain Robert Bonny twenty five pounds for one quarters Salary as Auditor General due as above.
