

Monday September the 16 1805

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Richard Hall Harwood, Allen B. Buckett and Oswald Chesler.

John Wilmot was appointed agent to bring Samuel Daugherty a fugitive from the Justice of this State, confined in the Jail of Philadelphia from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The said Wilmot is authorized to appoint a fit and proper person to accompany him who can identify the person of the said Daugherty.

Jacob Brown of the City of Baltimore was appointed agent to bring from the State of Virginia a certain Patrick McNeal who has been indicted in the Criminal Court of Baltimore County for fraudulently and wickedly defrauding a certain John Rice of his Goods and Chattels. Edward Holland was appointed to go with him.

Thursday September the 19 1805

The Council met. Present The Honble Richard Hall Harwood, Allen B. Buckett and Oswald Chesler.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honble John Bone the sum of one hundred and eighty seven pounds ten Shillings for one quarter Salary as Judge of the General Court due the first day of August.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honble Allen B. Buckett the sum of twenty six pounds five Shillings on account of fees for attending to certain Suits of the State in the General Court & as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. John Wilmot four pounds fourteen Shillings and one penny half penny for riding a pike to His Excellency the Governor as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Merian Pinkney seven pounds ten Shillings it being so much paid by him in advance for the Evening Post and American Citizen as per account passed by the Auditor.

By the Petition of William King and Henry Lamont of Baltimore County accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that they entered into a Recognizance in the sum of twenty pounds for the appearance of William King before the Justices of the Court of Oyer and Terminer & for Baltimore County at March Term last to give Evidence for the State against a certain George Adelsperger charged with feloniously stealing a Saddle. The Petitioners state that the said William King being sick did not attend at the Term aforesaid. They therefore pray a
