Friday October the 4. 1805

The Council met. Present The Honble Richard Hall Harwood, Allen B. Duckitt and Ovidy Ghieslin.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr John Wilmet the Sum of forty three pounds seven Shillings and three pence for riding Expens to the Governor of Pennsylvania as per account passed this day by the Auditor.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Samuel H. Smith, Esquire Ninety eight Dollars out of the Contingent Fund for printing done by order of the Governor and Council as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore be directed not to bring Suit against John C. Bond late Sheriff of Harford County until the first day of January next.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore be directed not to issue Execution on the Judgment obtained against James Walker until the first day of January next.
