

Friday January the 3. 1806

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Council.

By the Petition of David Stoddart of the City of Baltimore it appears that at a Court of Oyer and Terminer and Gaol Delivery for Baltimore County held on the second Monday in July one thousand eight hundred and three he was recognized in open Court in the sum of fifty pounds Current Money for the appearance of a certain Athanasius Moore before the Justices of the said Court to answer a charge against him for keeping a Gaming Table. that the said Moore attended the said Court according to the tenor of his Recognizance for several Terms preparing for trial, and that too to the knowledge of the Petitioner. The Petitioner states that in consequence of which he thought himself safe expecting that the said cause was finally determined. that some Months since the said Moore removed from this State to New Orleans and the Petitioner conceiving himself discharged from the said Recognizance took no steps to indemnify himself for the amount thereof. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said forfeiture.
