Wednesday March the 26. 1806

The Council met. Present The Honble Rowdy Gresham Richard Elghman Earle and Philip Reed.

The Board proceeded to elect a Chief Judge for the sixth Judicial District in the room of the honble Robert Smith who refused to accept and the Ballots being deposited in the Ballot Box and on examination thereof it appeared that the honble Joseph Hopper Nicholson was unanimously elected. Whereupon it is declared in the Council that the said Joseph Hopper Nicholson is duly elected Chief Judge of the said District and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Theophilus Felix Saugherty was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Baltimore County and Commission issued to the said County including him.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Edward Roberts twenty five Dollars and twenty one Cents for riding Express to the honble Richard Elghman Earle and Philip Reed as per account passed by the Auditor.

The following persons were appointed Inspectors of Tobacco at the respective Warehouses in Baltimore County to wit. At Falls Point Warehouse Nicholas Ridgely. At the Head of the Passon Rachel Doney. At Sugar and Bonnulls Josias Stevenson.

By the Petition of Moses C. Smith of Worcester County accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he was fined by the Court of the said County at November Term last for selling Corn by an unlawful measure the sum of three pounds two Shillings and six pence.
