The Council met Pursuit The Honble Rowdy Gresham Philip Read and Thomas W. Hall

The Board went into the appointment of a Clerk of Kent County in the room of Thomas Worrall Logue unsigned to hold the Clerksip until the meeting of the Court of the said County agreeably to the direction of the Constitution when Benjamin Chambers Logue was appointed and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Joseph Lands Francis Holland Samuel Tyler and Jonathan Tillman were appointed Justices of the Peace for Anne Arundel County and a New Commission issued including them.

Ordered that the order of Council which issued on the twenty fourth day of March last to the Treasurer of the Eastern Shore directing him to issue Execution against Benjamin Hatchinson a State debtor and his Securites be and the same is hereby suspended until the first day of October next.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Dobbin Logue Ninety six dollars for printing done for the State as per account paid by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mr. Jubb Fowler Ninety pounds seven Shillings and six pence as per account paid by the Auditor.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Perry Brown twenty two pounds ten Shillings for one quarters hall hay due the last instant.
