Wednesday May the 28. 1806

The Council met. Present The Honble Rowdy Chesler Philip Reid and Thomas. W. Hall

The Board went into the Appointment of a Clerk of West County in the room of Thomas Woodhiggen resigned. to hold the Clerkship until the meeting of the Court of the said County agreeably to the direction of the Constitution when Benjamin Chambers Esquire was appointed and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Joseph Sands Francis Holland Samuel Tyler and Jonathan Tillman were appointed Justices of the Peace for Anne Arundel County and a New Commission issued including them.

Ordered that the order of Council which issued on the twenty seventh day of March last to the Treasurer of the Eastern Shore directing him to issue execution against Benjamin Hatchison a State debtor and his securities be and the same is hereby suspended until the first day of October next.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Dobbin Esquire twenty six dollars for printing done for the State as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mr. Jubb Fowler Notary pounds seven Shillings and six pence as per account passed by the Auditor

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Perry Benson twenty two pounds ten Shillings for one quarters hall hire due the last Instant
