The following Proclamation was issued.

By His Excellency Robert Bowie Governor of Maryland  
A Proclamation

Whereas it has been stated to me by the Petition of a number of respectable persons inhabitants of Prince Georges County, that a Murder has been committed on the person of Charles Nevitt, Junior, late of Prince Georges County, by a certain Negro Man, a Slave of Basil Lopez, called Wall, who has since absconded and fled from Justice: And Whereas it is the duty of the Executive to guard as much as may be against the commission of such inhumanities, and to bring such offenders against the Law and peace of Society to Justice, I have therefore thought proper to issue this my Proclamation, and do, by and with the advice and consent of the Council, offer a Reward of one hundred Dollars to any person or persons who shall apprehend or secure the said Negro Wall in any Gaol in the United States so that he be brought to Justice: Given in Council at the City of Annapolis, under the Seal of the State of Maryland, this sixth day of September, in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five.

By the Petition of George Liddart of Baltimore County, accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of Oyer and Terminer and Assize for the said County it appears that he entered into a Recognizance in the sum of ten pounds for his appearance at the said Court at March Term last to give Evidence on behalf of the State of Maryland against a certain Benjamin Stoddale for an assault and Battery committed on the Petitioner. The Petitioner states that since the said Recognizance has been forfeited he has been before the Grand Jury and disclosed the particulars relative to the above mentioned assault. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said forfeiture.
