

presented by the Grand Jury of Prince Georges County at September Term eighteen hundred and five for keeping a Ferry across Patuxent River from Maguies to Lower Marlborough in Calvert County without having obtained a license for that purpose and at last April Term on submission he was fined fifty pounds. The Petitioner states that the omission of not taking out a license was owing to the then Associate Judge (Thomas Contee) who informed the Petitioner that it was not material for him to have a license as the State derived no advantage therefrom and that it was only necessary for the Petitioner to keep a good Ferry and not give room for complaint. That from being ignorant of the law himself and confiding in the opinion of Mr. Contee he incurred the penalty. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fine.

That they were called and forfeited. The Petitioner states that no persons appeared against Walter Brooke and the reason why he the said Walter did not appear was because he and the Magistrate deemed it unnecessary. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said Recognizance.
