The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Reverdy G. Chesler, Philip Reed and Thomas W. Hall.

On the application of William Goldborough Esquire of Frederick County for the preference in the purchase of the following Parcel of that Tract of Land called Taskus Chance late the property of Daniel Sulany, son of Daniel, lying and being in Frederick County beginning for said part at the end of twenty Perches in the third line of that part of said Land called "Taskus Chance" formerly conveyed by Daniel Sulany the Elder to Stephen Ransburgh for four hundred and twenty three Acres and running thence with said part the two following Courses, allowing four degrees for variation, South sixty six degrees East twenty Perches South sixty three degrees East fifty five and a half Perches, then North thirty three degrees East eight and a half Perches to edge of Monocoy River, then up by and with the Meanders thence of five following Courses and distances, North fifty five degrees West twenty Perches, North forty four and a half degrees West five Perches, North fifty nine degrees, West twenty seven Perches, North twenty four degrees West fourteen Perches, North forty three and a half degrees West seven Perches, then by a straight line to the first beginning containing five and a half Acres of Land which is said to be liable to confiscation. The Board agreed to sell the States right to said Parcel of Land for the sum of sixty dollars.
