The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Rewdy G. Chisler Francis Diggs Philip Reed and Thomas W. Hall

By the Petition of Gustavus Scott of Charles County it appears that he was fined by the Court of the said County at March Term eight hundred and six the sum of six pounds for keeping a Tavern in said County without having taken out a License. The Petitioner states that he has for several years past kept a Tavern in the said County and regularly obtained a License for the same. that at the Court when his License expired he was confined by a violent Illness and entirely unable to attend the Court. that as soon as he possibly could venture to ride he went to the House of Caleb Hawthorn Esquire Associate Justice for the purpose of procuring his License but was disappointed by Mr. Hawthorn's absence. The Petitioner further states that he remained too unwell to venture out a second time. that he had no intention of violating or wading the Law. The Board on consideration of which Circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said fine.
