

agreed to allow him the sum of one hundred dollars for the same. Whereupon ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the said Burton White one hundred dollars.

The Board took into consideration the account of James Carl, Junr. Clerk of the late General Court for the Eastern Shore for duties performed under and by virtue of the Act to provide for the organization and regulation of the Courts of Common Law in this State, and for the Administration of Justice therein and agreed to allow him the sum of four hundred and twenty dollars and no more for the same and the further sum of sixty dollars for transmitting the Papers to the Clerks of the respective Counties on the Eastern Shore. Whereupon ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the said James Carl Junr. the sum of five hundred and thirty dollars it being the whole amount allowed him as above.

By a Representation and Transcript from Caroline County Court it appears that David Whiting and Charles Manship entered into a Recognizance in the sum of nine hundred dollars for the appearance of the said David Whiting appearance before the Court of the said County at October Term eight hundred five to answer a presentment found against him for selling Nigro Ary out of the State as a Slave knowing her to be entitled to her freedom. The Court represent that the said David Whiting appeared at last October Term and offered himself ready to try the presentment against him and that it had been proved to their satisfaction, that at the last March Term, when the Recognizance of the said Whiting was forfeited that he was confined to such Bed in the City of Baltimore where he resided, and was disabled from some indisposition from attending the Court. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the whole of the said forfeiture.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honble Thomas W. Hall the sum of twenty eight pounds two shillings and six pence for half years salary as Clerk of the Senate due the first day of August last.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William P. Green sixty dollars and twenty five cents as per accounts passed by the Auditor General.
