or persons duly elected in each respective District. We, in pursuance of the direction of the said act, do  
by this our Proclamation declare, that by the Returns made to us it appears that John Campbell Esquire,  
was elected for the first District. Archibald Vanklor Esquire, was elected for the second District. Philip  
Barton Key Esquire, was elected for the third District. Roger Nelson Esquire, was elected for the fourth  
District. Nicholas Quatom More and William M. Curry Esquires, were elected for the fifth  
District. John Montgomery Esquire, was elected for the sixth District. Edward Lloyd Esquire, was  
elected for the seventh District, and Charles Goldsborough Esquire, was elected for the eighth  
District. Given in Council, at the City of Annapolis, under the Seal of the State of Maryland,  
the twenty fifth day of October, in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and six.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Aaron Schwabe the sum  
of fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay due the first Instant.

Ordered by The Governor, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant  
John Trueman fifteen pounds for one quarters half pay due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honble Francis Biggs  
the sum of one hundred pounds for six Months salary as a Member of the Council  
due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Nathan Pinkney the sum  
of twenty five pounds for one quarters salary as Clerk of the Council due as above.

Tuesday November the 4. 1806

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and The Honble Rowdy Chesler Philip Reid and Thomas W. Hall

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Gull Fowler the sum  
of twenty nine pounds thirteen Shillings and nine pence for one quarters salary  
as Messenger of the Council and Keeper of the State House due as above.

Ordered, that the said Treasurer pay to Captain Nicholas White twenty five  
pounds for six Months salary as Armorer at Francis Town due the first Instant.
