Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honble Philip Aud the sum of fifty pounds for one quarter salary as a Member of the Council due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honble Thomas W. Hall fourteen pounds one shilling and three pence for one quarter salary as Clerk of the Senate due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to the honble Thomas W. Hall fifty pounds for one quarter salary as a Member of the Council due the first Instant.

Friday November the 7. 1806

The Honble Rowdy Ghieslin, Philip Aud and Thomas W. Hall appeared in the Council Chamber.

Saturday November the 8. 1806

The Council met. Present The Honble Rowdy Ghieslin, Philip Aud and Thomas W. Hall

Honny Kemp Esquire was appointed a Justice of the orphans Court for Frederick County in the room of Patrick M. Gill Esquire resigned and Commission issued accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honble Rowdy Ghieslin the sum of fifty pounds for one quarter salary as a Member of the Council due the first Instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to the Honourable Littleton Dennis, the sum of thirty one pounds five shillings for salary due as Judge of the High Court of Appeals to the twentieth of November eighteen hundred and five.
