

On the second Monday in November and tenth day of the fourth Month in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and six the General Assembly of Maryland agreeably to the Constitution and Form of Government made and established in the Charter of a Colony when the Honble Robert Wright Esquire was elected
The next Monday following and eleventh day of the fourth Month the General Assembly of Maryland made choice of the Honble William Patterson as Counsel to the Governor to wit: Henry G. Fisher Thomas W. Hall Lewis Dunsell Philip Reed and James Mabb Esquires.

Wednesday November the 12. 1806

His Excellency Robert Wright Esquire qualified in the Senate Room in presence of the Members of both Houses of the General Assembly by taking the solemn Oath required by the Constitution and Form of Government, and the Laws of this State and by subscribing a Declaration of his belief in the Christian Religion, and also by taking the Oath to support the Constitution of the United States.

The Honble Henry G. Fisher Thomas W. Hall Lewis Dunsell Philip Reed and James Mabb Esquires in the Council Room and qualified before Gideon White Esquire one of the Justices of the Peace for Anne Arundel County by taking the solemn Oath required by the Constitution and Form of Government and Laws of this State and by subscribing a Declaration of their belief in the Christian Religion, and also by taking the Oath to support the Constitution of the United States.

Miriam Pashow was appointed Clerk of the Council and immediately qualified as such before Gideon White Esquire one of the Justices of the Peace for Anne Arundel County by taking repeating and subscribing the solemn Oath and the declaration provided for that purpose, and also by taking the Oath to support the Constitution of the United States.

Mr. Tubb Fowler was appointed Messenger to the Council.
