To all whom it may concern

Mr. Louis Francois Deloup having been appointed by his Imperial and Royal Majesty the Emperor of the French, and King of Italy, to be his Provisional Comissary of Commercial Relations at Baltimore, I do hereby recognize him as such, and declare him free to exercise and enjoy such functions, powers and privileges as are allowed to the similar Agents of the most favored Nations. In Testimony whereof, I have caused these letters to be made patent, and the Seal of the United States to be hereunto affixed. Given under my hand, at the City of Washington the eleventh day of June, in the Year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and six: and of the Independence of the United States of America the thirtieth.
