

John Hackett Junr. was appointed Surveyor of Queen Anne's County vice James Hackett deceased and Commission and Instructions issued to him accordingly.

Solomon Dickinson and John Howard were appointed Justices of the Peace Court for Talbot County vice William Thomas and Perry Brown resigned and Commission issued accordingly to William Hayward, Solomon Dickinson and John Howard as Justices of the Peace Court for the said County

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Jubb Fowler twenty four pounds eleven Shillings and four pence as per Account passed by the Auditors.

Ordered that the act, entitled, an act to prevent free Negroes from selling any Corn, wheat or Tobacco, without having a license for that purpose from a Justice of the Peace, and the act to restrain the evil practice arising from Negroes keeping dogs and to prohibit them from carrying Guns or offensive Weapons, be published once in each Week, until the first day of May next, in the Maryland Gazette, at Annapolis, the American and Federal Gazette, at Baltimore, the Republican Advocate, at Frederick Town and the Republican Star at Easton.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Joseph Dawson the sum of three pounds fifteen Shillings for one quarter's half pay due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Jubb Fowler, thirty nine pounds one Shilling and three pence, for one quarter's Salary as Messenger of the Council and Keeper of the State House due the first Instant.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honorable Lewis Duvall the sum of fifty pounds for one quarter's Salary as Member of the Council due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honorable Thomas W. Hall the sum of fifty pounds for one quarter's Salary as a Member of the Council due as above.

Whereas William Rose, James Booker and Philemon Willis Securities of William S. Bond a State Debtor has forfeited the benefit of a Resolution passed at Annapolis September eighteenth hundred and four in consequence of a neglect on their part to pay the Interest on the Judgment therein mentioned: And Whereas the said William Rose, James Booker and Philemon Willis have prayed to be restored to the benefit of the said Resolution: Therefore ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore be and he is hereby authorized and directed not to issue Execution against the said William Rose, James Booker and Philemon Willis provided they pay on or before the first day of April next all the Interest that may be due on the said Judgment.
