The Executive appointed James Houston and Richard Ridgely Esquires to superintend for the State (the Honourable the Attorney General being previous to his appointment engaged as Counsel for the complainants) the four following Cases in the Chancery Court to wit, Norris against the State. Hall against the State. French against the State. Cortee against the State.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mrs Betty Simmons two pounds eight Shillings and nine pence for one quarter pay cleaning and taking care of the Public Muffery due the first Instant.
