Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honourable Philip Reed, Seven Dollars, it being the amount paid by him to Mr. Bradley for the Map of the United States purchased for the use of the Governor and Council.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Miriam Cookney one Dollar it being the amount paid by him to Cook the Stage Driver for bringing the Map of the United States from the City of Washington which was purchased from Mr. Bradley for the use of the Governor and Council.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to John D. Colborn Esquire twenty Dollars as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Frederick Green Esquire twenty six pounds twelve shillings and four pence half penny as per account passed.

Whereas by the Resolution passed at the last Session of the Council a copy of Maryland The Bills of Exchange and Certificates issued by virtue of the Act of Severation hundred and twenty nine Chapter thirty eight are directed to be paid out of any unappropriated Money in the Treasury with Interest and Cost of Protest. And Whereas Speculators have and may continue to avail themselves of the ignorance of the Holders of said Bills and Certificates and fraudulently obtain the same. Ordered that the said Resolution be published once in each Week for the space of six Weeks in the Maryland Gazette at Annapolis, the American and Federal Gazette at Baltimore, the Republican Advocate at Indian Town, the Maryland Herald at Hagerstown and the Republican Star at Centon.

Ordered that the act which was directed to be published in the 17th be inserted until the first day of May next in the Maryland Herald at Hagerstown.
