Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mrs Rebecca Forest the sum of ninety Dollars for one quarter half pay due the first day of February last.

Joseph Latimer not having given Bond within the time prescribed by Law his Commission as Coroner of Queen Anne's County became vacated. Whereupon the Board appointed him and a New Commission issued to him accordingly.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and all the Council

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Merian Pinkney Esquire the sum of seven hundred and thirtyn Dollars and two thirds of a Dollar for Alphabetizing and completing the Proprietary Sett Books agreeably to the Resolution of November Session eighteen hundred and five.

The Board having considered the Resolution authorizing them to order such Repairs to be made to the Senate Chamber and the Room occupied by the House of Delegates, as to them shall appear necessary. Likewise the Resolution authorizing them to furnish the House of Delegates with twenty one convenient writing Desks and so forth came to the following order.
