Saturday May the 2. 1807

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honble Owerdy Gherkin Thomas W. Hall Lewis Duvall and James Mabb.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. William Tuck the sum of three hundred Dollars to be used in repairing the House of Delegates Room and by him to be accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Nicholas White for his services as Announcer at Frederick Town from the first day of November to first day of May Instant the sum of Ninety six pounds, and that the said Nicholas White be continued as Announcer till the first day of November next on the same terms and conditions, on which he has heretofore held the said Appointment.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honourable Lewis Duvall the sum of fifty pounds for one quarter salary as a Member of the Council due the first Instant.

Monday May the 4. 1807

Ordered that Commission issue to him. Commission issued accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Jubb Fowler nineteen pounds seven Shillings and three pence as per account passed by the Auditor.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mr. Joseph Dawson the sum of ten Dollars for one quarter half pay due the first Instant.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Mrs. Ann Le Vacher fifteen pounds for one quarter half pay due as above.
