Friday May the 29. 1807

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honourable Rowdy G. Child. Thomas W. Hall and Lewis Duwall.

Peter Dashiell Esquire was appointed a Justice of the Orphans Court for Somerset County vice Thomas Hamilton deceased and Commission issued to John Galt, James Bennett and Peter Dashiell Esquire, as Justices of the Orphans Court of said County.

Unit Angier Esquire was appointed a Justice of the Orphans Court for Hunt County in the room of Thomas Wilkerson of Thomas deceased, and Commission issued to James Hodges Junia, Philip F. Rezin and Unit Angier as Justices of the Orphans Court of said County.

Leffe M. Sherwood Esquire was appointed Coroner for Lunenburg County vice Philmond Murphy Esquire who refused to accept and Commission issued to him accordingly.

John Smith Brooks was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Prince Georges County and New Commission issued to the said County including him and leaving out Samuel J. Coolege.

Leonard Covington was appointed Coroner for Prince Georges County and a Commission issued to him accordingly.

Samuel Lane was appointed a Justice of the Levy Court for Montgomery County vice Henry Brooks deceased and Commission issued to the said County including him and leaving out Henry Brooks.

Ordered that Mr. Tubb Fowler the Messenger of the Council prevent any person from acting in a rude and disorderly manner and particularly from playing Ball within the State House, and if wanted to call in such a instance as may be necessary for that purpose.

Ordered that the Attorney General be authorized and he is hereby requested to cause to be issued, the necessary Judicial Process for the recovery of all debts due to the State on Judgments excepting Cases in which Indulgences have been or may hereafter be granted by this Board.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Perry Benson twenty two pounds ten Shillings for one quarters half pay due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore be directed not to bring Suit against Abram Bone Esquire late Sheriff of Prince Georges County on account of balance due the State until the first day of August next.
