Wherefore Resolved, that the Letter of Colonel Reed of the 14 Instant be considered a non acceptance of the office of Adjutant General.

The Board proceeded to Ballot for an Adjutant General of the State of Maryland via Philip Reed Esquire: on examination of the Ballots it appeared that Samuel Turbutt Wright Esquire had a majority of Votes. - Whereupon it is declared in the Council that the said Samuel Turbutt Wright Esquire, is duly elected Adjutant General of the State of Maryland: Ordered, that Commission issue to him: Commission accordingly issued.
