Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore advance to Richard Ridgely and James Houston, Esquires, one hundred Dollars each out of the Contingent Fund in part compensation for their services in defending four Suits in Chancery against the State, in which the Attorney General had been employed by the Plaintiffs previous to his appointment to that office.
