Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore advance to Captain Nicholas White Armour at Frederick Town one hundred Dollars out of the Contingent Fund for the purpose of repairing sundry State Muskets, to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the honourable Lewis Duwall fifty pounds for one quarter salary as a Member of the Council due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Minian Pinkney the sum of twenty five pounds for one quarter salary as Clerk of the Council due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mrs Rebecca Forrest the sum of thirty three pounds fifteen shillings for one quarter half pay due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Captain Robert Denny, seventy five pounds for one quarter salary as Auditor General, due as above.

Ordered by the Governor that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain James Sommersell twenty two pounds ten shillings for one quarter half pay due as above.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant John Dyson, fifteen pounds for one quarter half pay due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Roger Esquire, fourteen pounds one shilling and three pence for one quarter salary as Clerk of the Senate due as above.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Frederick Gunn Esquire, forty seven pounds twelve shillings and six pence as per account passed by the Auditor.
