spirituous liquor against law. The Petitioner further states that the sale for which
he has been fined was made by his Wife, at a time when he was in the City of Baltimore.
The Petitioner further states, that his said Wife had no authority from him to sell a less
quantity than was authorized by law, and he believes that he did not know that the
law prohibited the sale of any quantity however small. The Board on consideration
